Subject: ADHERENCE TO CODE OF CONDUCT BY CIVIL SERVANTS ASPIRING FOR ALLOTMENT OF GOVERNMENT OWNE RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION.


It has been noted with grave concern that officers of APUG and ex-Cadre are involved in breach of conduct pertaining to Rules and Regulations governing allotment of residential accommodation. In the past civil servants used their influence and bypassed General Waiting List and managed allotments in relaxation of rules under Rule 29-A. This practice created heartburning and few got out of turn concession by depriving their senior colleagues. The ironical part is that the people got allotments five to six years in advance, therefore, minimize chances of allotment from the General Waiting List.

2. The M/o Housing & Works has reviewed its policy regarding allotment of Government accommodation to bring it in line with the Supreme Court's orders to streamline working and bring transparency in the allotment process and procedure. A number of government officers/officials by taking undue leverage of their positions try to influence/pressurize the officers in the Ministry/Estate Office for fresh allotment or revalidation of the allotments earlier made to them but stand withdrawn. The General Waiting List has been placed on the website of this Ministry for the convenience of the Government employees. They may peruse their seniority on the GWL on the website and in case of any grievance they may approach this Ministry through their Ministry/department for alleviation of the same instead of visiting the Ministry/Estate Office.

3. Further it is also requested that all the FGS aspiring for allotment of accommodation should apply in the Estate Office/Ministry may be advised to apply for the same through proper channel and strictly abide by the E&D Rules especially in context of allotment of government accommodation.
